Otherwise, sinking a shovel into the ground could result in serious injury, widespread service disruptions or costly repairs for which you could be liable.



To avoid problems, you can arrange to have utility lines located and marked for free

by calling Texas 811 at least 48 business hours before you plan to dig. You can also visit www.texas811.org for more information.
