EPCOR's Water Main Cost Sharing Application Procedures

1. Companies eligible for the Program must apply using Sheet B of the As-built Quantities and Costs Report in the CCC Application Package. One application is required for each phase of a project within a specific land servicing agreement. The application must be signed and sealed by the Project Engineer. The As-built Quantities and Costs Report can be obtained on EPCOR's web site www.epcor.com or by contacting the following person:

2. Upon receipt of the application, EPCOR will verify the applicant's eligibility for the Program as well as the applied for rebate amount. In addition, the supporting documentation will be verified to ensure it is complete and to the satisfaction of EPCOR. EPCOR is making all payments via direct deposit. Please request and complete the EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) form by contacting accounts-payable@epcor.com in order to receive payments from EPCOR electronically. The payment will be processed based on the CCC Approval Date, as signed by the City Planning and Development representative.
